- Admin News - the purpose being to ensure our school community has the day to day information they need to be fully informed. The upcoming events and dates etc.

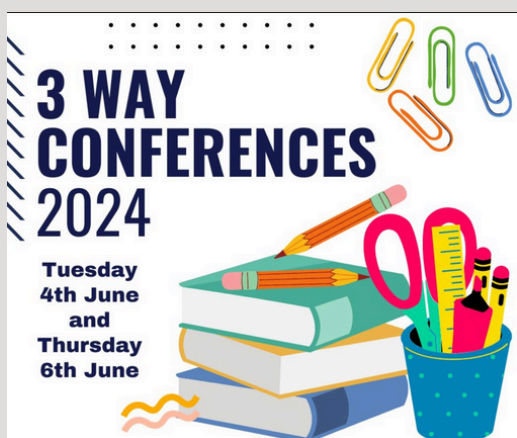
This communication will be sent out 3 times a term....on a Sunday (as this is when you will be thinking school again :))
