IMPORTANT UPDATES

TEACHER ONLY DAY

You may have seen talk in the media about schools having Teacher Only Days in term time. I would like to clarify some misconceptions following this news item.

The Ministry of Education states the number of 1/2 days a school must be open for instruction each year. This year we planned for 2 Teacher Only Days, one in Term 2 and one in Term 4. While these days are in term time, they are not counted in the number of 1/2 days the school is open for instruction.

So why do you need Teacher Only Days? To complete professional development as a whole staff. With two different governments that have differing priorities things in education are constantly changing, more now than ever!

In 2023 the Labour government starting 'refreshing' areas of the curriculum and in 2024 National has 'refreshed the refresh'......confusing? Basically we have had two versions in 1 year.

What has this meant for us? We have taken time to be aware of and to understand the changes however we have continued doing what we have always done - planned and assessed teaching and learning programmes that meet the needs of learners in our school, and in our class. We have very positive levels of progress and achievement, we know what we do works!

At the beginning of this term, after consultation, the Final English and Mathematics curriculums will be available. On the 25th of October we have a planned Teacher Only Day which will be used to analyse these curriculums. We will be noticing what's the same, what's different and making decisions as a whole staff in regards to the way forward. What changes do we need to make to our planning, teaching and assessment to ensure we are providing our learners with quality teaching and learning.

ROADING AND PARKING

If you have passed school in the last few days you may have noticed that the grass area at the back of the school has been gravelled. We have been working with AT Transport to prepare for road closure in the near future. The exact date has not been confirmed, however at some point in November Alfriston Road will be closed for at least a few weeks. This is going to have quite an impact for us at school. The staff carpark won't be available, the kiss n go won't be available, the front carparks won't be available and access to the school office from Alfriston Road won't be available.

The gravel area will provide some additional parking off Mill Road, however we will need to implement some careful systems to ensure our learners are safe coming to and from school.

Please keep an eye out for future communications, as these will confirm closure dates and provide information in regards to the systems we will implement.
